

## Ethylene Absorber User Guide

## Model 19011 Mini Blanket 10in x 10in / 25.4cm x 25.4cm

- 1. Remove blanket from the barrier bag packaging
- 2. Remove self-locking tie taped to the outside of the bag
- 3. Hang blanket from the fan guard, suspended in direct air flow. If cooler design allows, hang on the return air side. Use self-locking tie or metal hooks to secure in place, making sure there is some clearance between the blanket and the fan.
- 4. Use one blanket for each fan in the cooler



## Note:

- It's essential for blankets to be in the main air flow for maximum absorption of ethylene.
- It's normal for blankets to get dirty on the outside, over time. As the absorbing beads filter ethylene, the filter material also traps dirt particles from the air.
- Air Repair<sup>™</sup> beads are a bright purple color when fresh. Upon exposure to air, and as ethylene is oxidized, they turn
  brown starting from the surface and eventually penetrating to the core of the bead.
- Blankets should be replaced every 6 months for continued protection of your ethylene sensitive products
